

**Directions to St. Edward State Park**  
**Located at the north end of Lake Washington in Kenmore, Wash.**

**From I-405 northbound:**

Take exit #20-A (NE 116th St.) and turn west (left). Travel 4.5 miles -- downhill on 116<sup>th</sup> across 98th Ave. where the road name changes to Juanita Dr and winding uphill along Lake Washington. Park entrance is on left. (Signs say Bastyr University and St. Edward State Park.)

**From I-405 southbound:**

Exit at Hwy. 522 (exit #23-B). Drive through traffic lights in Bothell to Kenmore. Turn left at 68th Ave NE. (68th turns into Juanita Dr.) Park is 1.5 miles on the right. (Signs say Bastyr University and St. Edward State Park.)

**From I-5:**

Take exit #175 (145th St.) and travel east to Bothell Way. Turn left. Travel along the north edge of lake Washington to 68th Ave NE. in Kenmore. (68th turns into Juanita Dr). Park is 1.5 miles on the right. (Signs say Bastyr University and St. Edward State Park.)

**Find Wilderness Awareness School inside the park**

Follow the park road, take a right at the junction (left takes you to Bastyr University), and then turn left into either the parking strip or the parking lot.
