## ***To Duvall***

### **From Monroe**

Take Highway 203 south 8 miles to the north edge of Duvall. Follow *“coming from the north”* below.

### **From I-90 heading east**

1. Take Exit 22 (Preston) and at the “T”, turn right onto Preston-Fall City Road.
2. Go 4 miles. At the stop sign in Fall City, turn right, go over the bridge, then left onto Highway 203.
3. Follow Highway 203 12 miles through Carnation, past Stillwater, and through Duvall.
4. *Follow the “coming from the south” directions below.*

### **From Seattle**

1. Take Highway 520 over Lake Washington to Redmond until it turns into Avondale Road.
2. Follow Avondale Road through 3 stoplights. Just before the 4<sup>th</sup> stoplight, take the right fork onto Novelty Hill Road.
3. Follow Novelty Hill Road until it curves steeply downhill into the river valley.
4. At the stop light, turn left, go one block, and turn right onto 124<sup>th</sup> St.
5. Go across the valley over the bridge.
6. At the round-about, turn left onto Highway 203.
7. Follow Highway 203 2.5 miles through Duvall.
8. *Follow the “coming from the south” directions below to the office or the land.*

### **From North Seattle**

1. Take Highway 522 from Bothell to the second Woodinville exit, Woodinville/Duvall
2. Follow the Woodinville/Duvall Road 9 miles
3. Go steeply downhill into the river valley and across the Duvall bridge.
4. Turn left at the light onto Hwy 203.
5. *Follow the “coming from the south” directions below to the office or the land.*

## ***To our Office: 26425 NE Allen Street, Ste. 203***

### **Coming from the north:**

The first business just as you enter Duvall is GSR Rentals on your right. **Make a sharp hairpin left turn onto Cherry Valley Road across from GSR Rentals.** Go 100 feet and at the 25 mph arrow, take your first right on NE Allen St. Continue up hill for 50 feet. Turn right into the second parking lot on the right.

### **Coming from the south:**

Drive all the way through Duvall, past the last stoplight at the bridge intersection. Go one block. **Take the right fork onto Cherry Valley Road across from GSR Rentals** (this turn is before the speed limit on Hwy 203 changes to 55 MPH). Go 100 feet and at the 25 mph arrow, take your first right on NE Allen St. Continue up hill for 50 feet. Turn right into the second parking lot on the right.

***To our Land: Linne Doran 20401 320th Ave NE  
(Cedar Lodge, Wolf Den, Malalo, Inipi).***

Estimated Travel Time: 15-20 Minutes.

START: Wilderness Awareness Office (Duvall)

1. From the office parking lot, turn left onto Allen Street, curve left down the hill to the Stop Sign.
2. TURN RIGHT onto Cherry Valley Road. Continue to junction of Mtn. View Road. (4.0 miles)
3. TURN LEFT onto Mountain View Road. Continue to a hairpin right curve. (0.6 miles)
4. FOLLOW CURVE to right and continue on Mtn. View Road. (0.4 miles)
5. FOLLOW RIGHT FORK (go straight) onto 318<sup>th</sup> Ave. NE. (Watch for Yield and Dead End signs)
6. 318<sup>th</sup> Ave. NE becomes 183<sup>rd</sup> Street. CONTINUE around curves and up hill for (0.3 miles).
7. TURN LEFT onto 320<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE. Continue for (0.8 miles)
8. CONTINUE STRAIGHT when you see the sign for NE 197<sup>th</sup> Street / Lk Margaret. (Road becomes gravel).
9. CONTINUE on 320<sup>th</sup> Ave. NE to "Mosswood Hollow" sign VEER RIGHT. (0.2 miles)
10. At this point you should see Wilderness Awareness and Linne Doran entrance signs.
11. About 200 ft after the entrance see parking on the left. Please pull in and park head first here.
12. Continue walking along the gravel road. Veer right past the "honey buckets".
13. You will see Cedar Lodge (2 story tan building with porch).
14. To get to Wolf Den (the yurt) continue on the path right of Cedar Lodge to a cutoff to your right.
15. To get to Malalo (the fire ceremony area), continue on the path right of Cedar Lodge and a few hundred feet past the Wolf Den to a trail on the right which leads to Malalo.

Please limit your speed to 10 MPH on the gravel road to protect our students and wildlife.
